Dear Messrs. Hansen, Kjell, Lerenius:

On behalf of the undersigned conservation and animal welfare organizations representing hundreds of millions of people worldwide, we urge you to immediately and permanently halt plans to capture and export five young live elephants from your Namibia property, *Eden Wildlife* (which appears to be owned by the Ittur Group), ¹ to *Safari Park Dubai* in the United Arab Emirates. ² *Eden Wildlife* has already previously exported nine live elephants to Mexico in 2012.³

Elephants are extremely intelligent, sentient animals, with a highly organized social structure including strong family bonds that can last a lifetime. Elephants are significantly harmed by trauma of forced

removal from their herds. Young elephants are dependent on their mothers and the herds to acquire necessary social and behavior skills. Disruption of this bond is physically and psychologically traumatic for a calf. In recognition of this, Namibia's neighbor, South Africa, prohibits the capture and export of wild elephants for captive use.⁴ Furthermore, the IUCN SSC African Elephant Specialist Group opposes the removal of African elephants from the wild for captive use because there is "no direct benefit for *in situ* conservation."⁵ Finally, if the removal of these elephants from the wild is intended as a population growth control measure or a response to drought, we note that immunocontraception has proven extremely effective for this purpose; indeed, over 800 elephant cows in 24 reserves in South Africa are being treated with immunocontraception.⁶

Instead of a life in their natural habitat with their families, what awaits these five animals is cruelty, stress, and potential death, during capture, taming, transport, and a lifetime in captivity in Dubai. Indeed, four wild-caught young elephants shipped from Zimbabwe to captive facilities in China over the past few years reportedly died either during transport or shortly after arrival. Once in Dubai, the *Eden Wildlife* elephants are likely to be offered for elephant rides, which may require "taming" using harsh techniques including withholding of water and food and painful physical restraints in order to force the animals to submit to human dominance. Further trouble may await the elephants including exposure to extreme desert heat in temperatures well in excess of those in Namibia, which will further compromise their welfare.

For these reasons, we respectfully request that you immediately and permanently halt the planned capture and export of any live elephants from your property in Namibia for captive use in Dubai or elsewhere.
